ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

At Highland Holiday Cottages we are committed to providing high quality self catering accommodation whilst also minimising the environmental impact of all our activities. We encourage our guests to help us in providing eco-friendly holiday accommodation through their actions while staying with us.

To contribute positively to our environment, Highland Holiday Cottages take the following actions:

- Low energy lighting is fitted where possible.
- Timers are fitted to all outdoor lighting.
- We shall replacing broken or worn-out appliances with energy efficient models.
- Glass, cans, paper, etc. is collected for recycling.
- Wherever possible eco detergents / products are used in all cottages.
- Each cottage is thoroughly insulated and double glazed.
- Recycled paper is used in all of our stationery as well as for toilet tissues.
- Providing a natural pond / garden habitat which encourage wildlife.
- Promoting a “smoke outside” policy for the benefit of all our guests.
- Setting annual environmental improvement objectives and targets (available to the public).

Guests can assist us implement our Environmental Policy by:

- Turning off lights and appliances when not in use to minimise energy usage.
- Turning off room heating if the cottage is too hot or if you leave the cottage.
- Our water comes from Cruben Beag Spring so use water wisely.
- Do not flush anything but toilet paper.
- Shop locally – Kingussie Shops can supply most of your needs.
- Buy locally produced food - visit Farmers Markets & Butcher.
- Buy items with out unnecessary packaging.
- Separate out your clean - Glass, Paper Cans and place them in to the recycling.
